ADVANCED SKILL SET CERTIFICATE (ASSC)

PROGRAM HOURS: 37

Exams are independent of graduation requirements. State and federal financial aid are not available for advanced skill set certificates.

CERTIFICATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE (CAS)

PROGRAM HOURS: 43

Prepare for a career in barbering. New River CTC's certificate of applied science exceeds the 1200 clock hours required by the West Virginia State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. Exams are independent of graduation requirements.



COSMETOLOGY

CERTIFICATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE (CAS)

PROGRAM HOURS: 58

Focus on a career oriented program in salon management and cosmetology. Gain hands-on experience in the Cosmetology Program Salon. This program exceeds then 1800 clock hours required by the West Virginia Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. Students will be eligible to take the State board examination provided all eligibility requirements are met. Exams are independent of graduation requirements.

ESTHETICS

CERTIFICATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE

PROGRAM HOURS: 30

The Esthetics program is a branch of the cosmetology program focusing on skin care and makeup. The certificate program exceeds the 600 clock hours required for licensure by the West Virginia Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. Upon completion of the Esthetics program, students will be eligible for the examination administered by the Board provided all eligibility requirements are met.

ADVANCED SKILL SET CERTIFICATE

PROGRAM HOURS: 14

Nail Care Technician services include the cleaning, shaping, conditioning and care for the fingers, hands, toes and feet as well as the preparation and application of artificial nails. New River CTC's Nail Care Technician program consists of 400 contact hours as required for licensure by the West Virginia Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. Students must present a copy of their license to be awarded the advanced skill set certificate. State and federal financial aid are not available for advanced skill set certificates.
