

Veteran/Spouse Priority of Service Form

The term 'Priority of Service' refers to the specific rights that veterans and eligible spouses of veterans have in all training services provided through the Department of Labor (DOL) funded training programs. In circumstances where a grant recipient must choose between two qualified candidates for a service, one of whom is a veteran or eligible spouse, the veteran priority of service provisions require that the grant recipient give the veteran or eligible spouse priority of service by first providing him or her that service. A copy of the veteran's DD214 must be submitted to verify eligibility.

- A spouse of a veteran who is eligible to receive Priority of Service based on the veteran having served at least one day in the active military, naval, or air service, and who was discharged or released from service under any condition other than a dishonorable discharge. This definition includes Reserve units and National Guard units activated for Federal Service.
- Veteran/Spouse of Veteran is not eligible to receive Priority of Service.
