TITLE: Drug-Free Campus Plan and Committee

RATIONALE: The purpose of the plan is to comply with the requirements for the U.S. Department of Education Drug Prevention Program Certification. The plan also provides for the establishment of a campus-wide committee on Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention.

POLICY STATEMENT

The Campus-Wide Committee on Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention is established to plan and evaluate campus-wide drug and alcohol abuse prevention activities and to monitor compliance with federal statutes.

Program Advisors (one from each campus)
Faculty Representative
Student Government Representatives (one from each campus)

Common Goal Implementation of activities college-wide for the prevention, education and intervention in the instances of alcohol and drugs.

Objectives To plan employee and student programs on prevention, education and intervention as related to drugs and alcohol;

To evaluate all policies, procedures and programs related to drugs and alcohol to determine their effectiveness and to implement any changes to the program when needed; and

To ensure that college policies and procedures are consistent with Federal statutes.
