You may qualify for a West Virginia Invests Grant* if you:

- Were a legal resident of West Virginia for at least 1 year immediately before applying;
- Are a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen for federal financial aid;
- Are a graduate of a public, private or homeschool program, or have successfully passed a high school equivalency test;
- Have not already earned a college degree (associate level or higher) or attempted 90 hours or more college credit hours;
- Are in compliance with the college's Satisfactory Academic Progress policy; for renewal you must also have a 2.0 cumulative grade point average;
- Have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- Are not in default on a federal student loan;
- Meet the minimum admissions requirements at an eligible institution and register for at least 6 credit hours;
- Are willing to make a commitment to improving the state by living in West Virginia for at least two years after graduation and completing at least 2 hours of unpaid community service each academic term; and
- Pay for and pass a drug screening during the 60 days prior to the start of the first term you are enrolled and eligible for an award in each academic year. You may be required to take another drug screening during the academic year and/or complete other requirements.

* The WV Invests Grant covers the cost of basic tuition, mandatory fees and approved academic program fees. The maximum award amount is limited to the total cost of tuition, mandatory fees and academic program fees charged to a student, regardless of program, minus other grant or scholarship aid. The WV Invests Grant does not cover program equipment and supply fees, the cost of textbooks and other course material. Contact New River CTC's Financial Aid Office for information on additional expenses you may be required to pay.
