

# CDL

Complete Class A CDL, Class B CDL or Pintle Hook training and test on-site at New River CTC's Advanced Technology Center in Ghent, WV. Students interested in any of the CDL programs are required to have a valid- unrestricted driver's license for a minimum of two (2) years. Additionally, students must also obtain a Class A or Class B CDL learner's permit\* before the first day of class and successfully pass a drug screening.

\*Written tests as required by the DMV for the Class A and Class B CDL learner's permit, and any endorsements, are completed at the DMV.

## CLASS A CDL

The Class A CDL training lasts six weeks and is offered Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. preparing you to enter the workforce quickly. The program features hands-on experience driving a truck with guaranteed small class sizes. Testing is provided on site.

Upon completion, successful students receive their CDL license along with a 180-hour certificate. First-year drivers earn an average of \$40,000. Experienced drivers can earn between \$60,000 and \$100,000 per year.

Certification options include:

- Class A license
- Tanker endorsement
- Doubles and Triples endorsement
- Hazmat endorsement
- School Bus and Passenger endorsement

## CLASS B CDL

The Class B CDL class is a four-day course, offered Monday through Thursday, designed to give you the necessary training and seat time to earn your license with the school bus and passenger endorsement training. Testing is provided on site.

## PINTLE HOOK

The Class A CDL Pintle Hook training is a 17-hour hands-on course, offered after 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday, designed for those working in the utility industry. Testing is provided on site.
